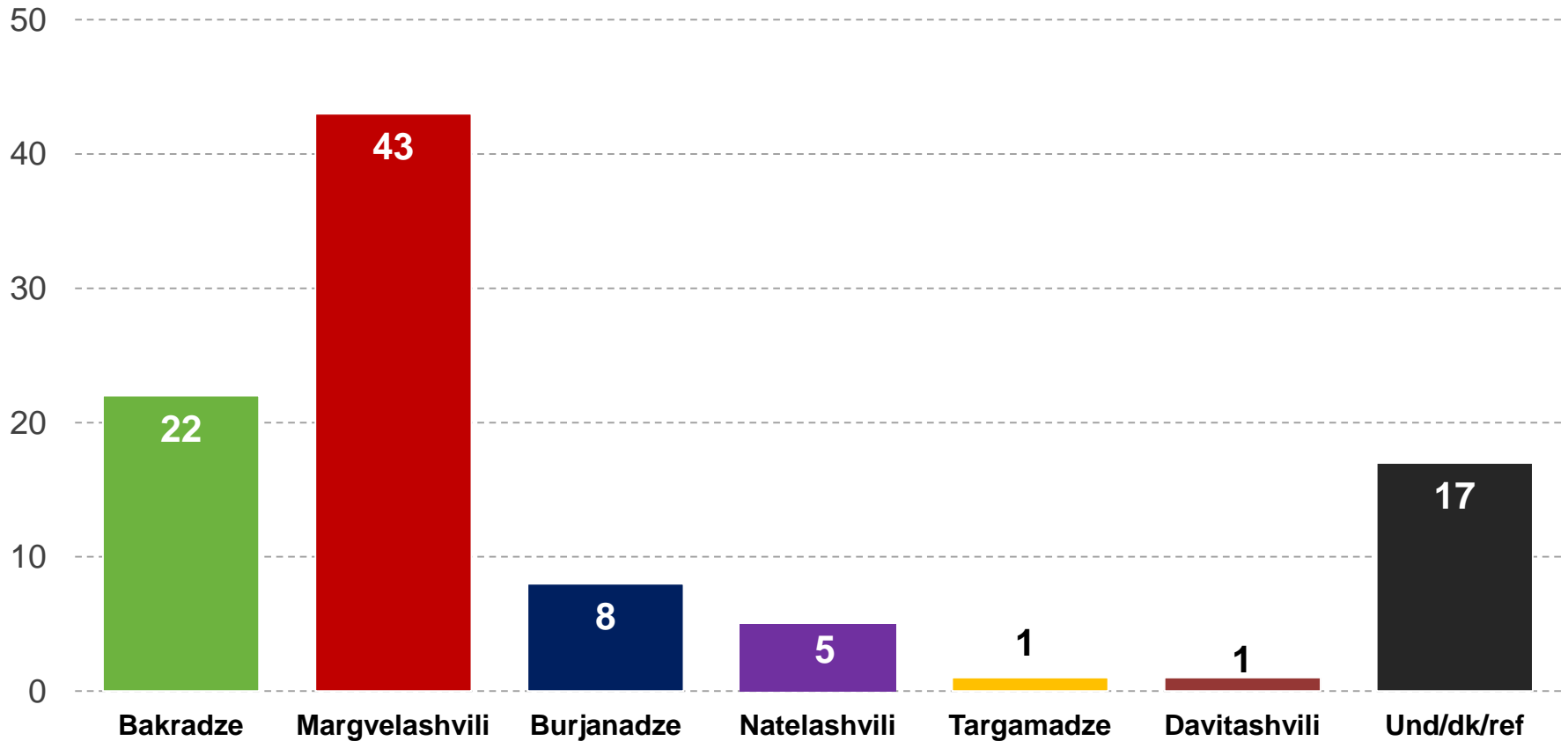
Results from the September 2013 Survey

The research

- Nation-wide survey; 1,204 face-to-face interviews.
- Conducted 15-21 September, 2013
- Random, stratified sample of adults
- 698 “likely” voters (corresponds to 58% turnout)
- Margin of sampling error:
 - +/- 2.8% on total sample
 - +/- 3.7% among likely voters
- Conducted on behalf of Georgia Presidential Administration, designed by Washington-based GQR, under the direction of Dr. Jeremy Rosner. Field work conducted by BCG.

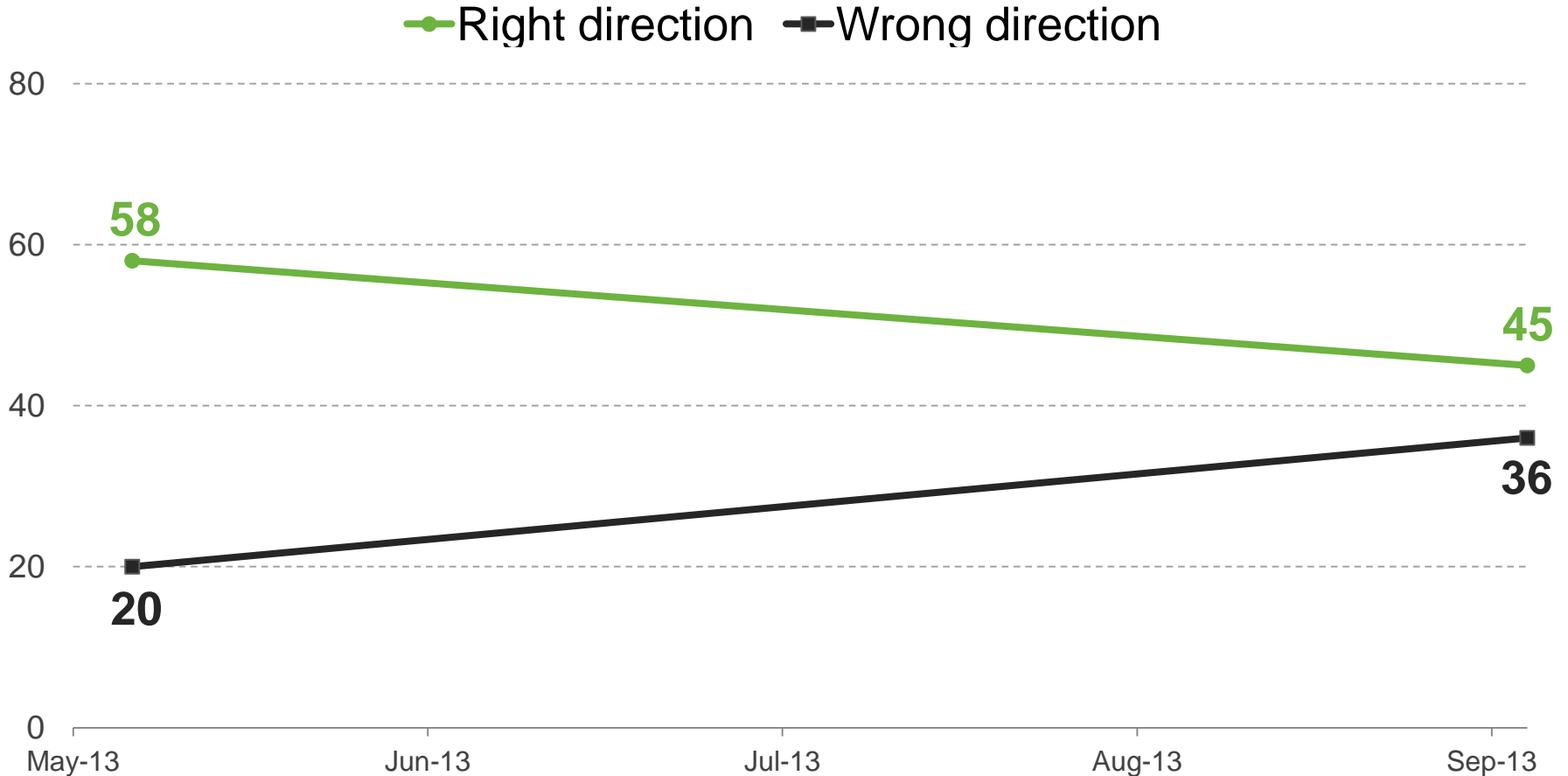
Presidential vote preference | likely voters

Although the next presidential election is not until 27 October, if the next presidential election were held today, for which candidate would you vote, if the choices were the following:



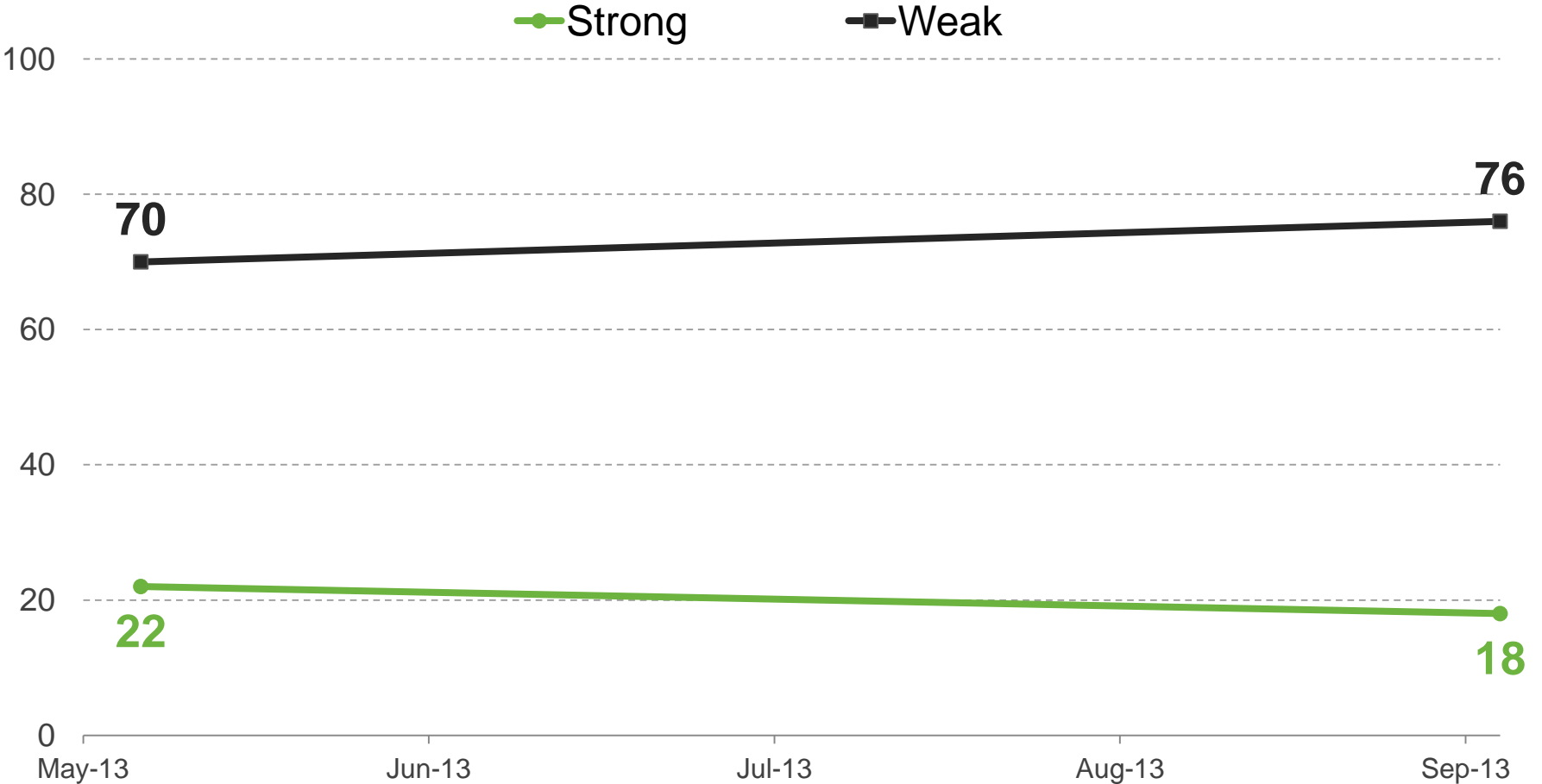
Country direction

Generally speaking, do you think that things in Georgia are going in the right direction, or do you feel things are going in the wrong direction?



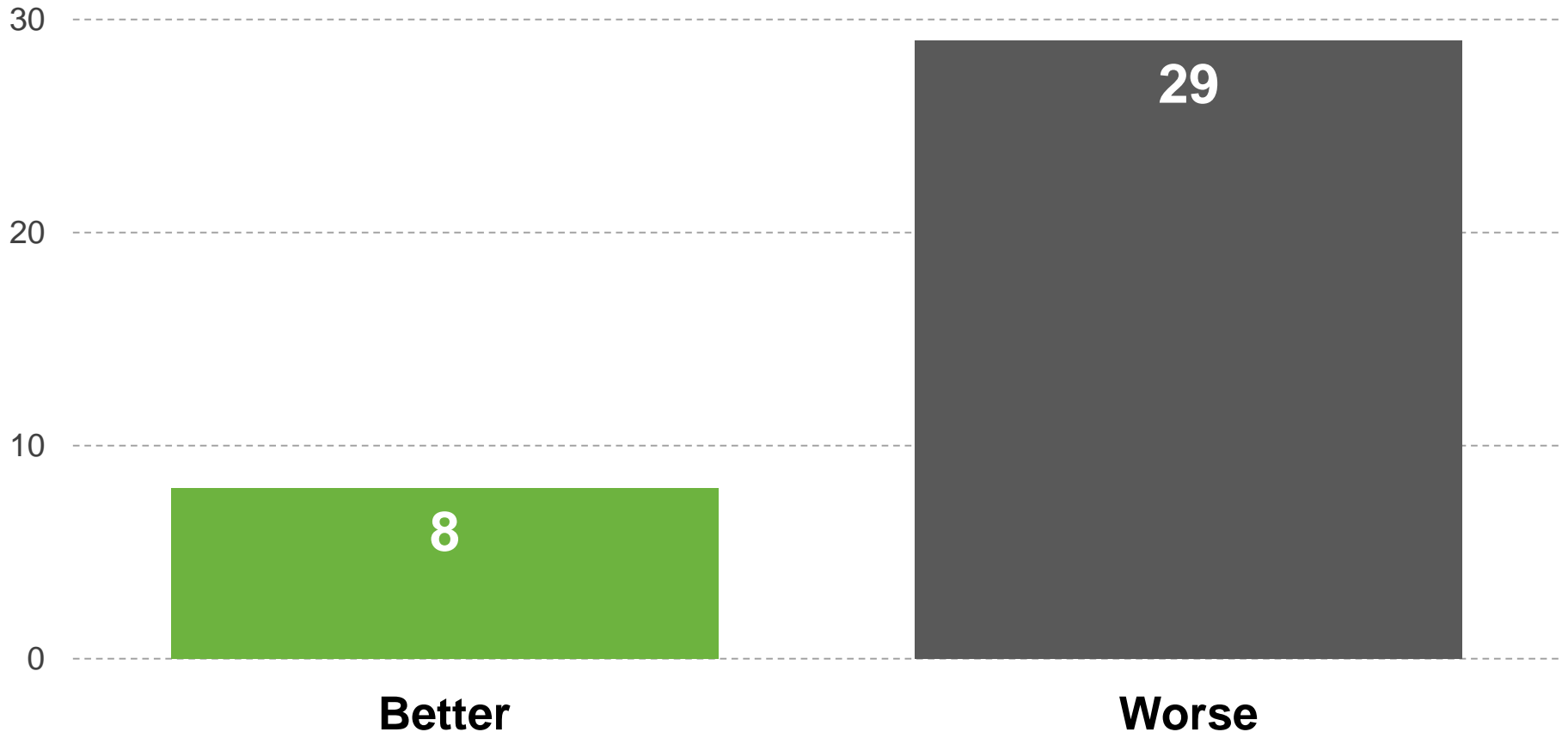
Strength of economy

Now I want to ask you about the economy. Would you say Georgia's economy right now is strong or weak?



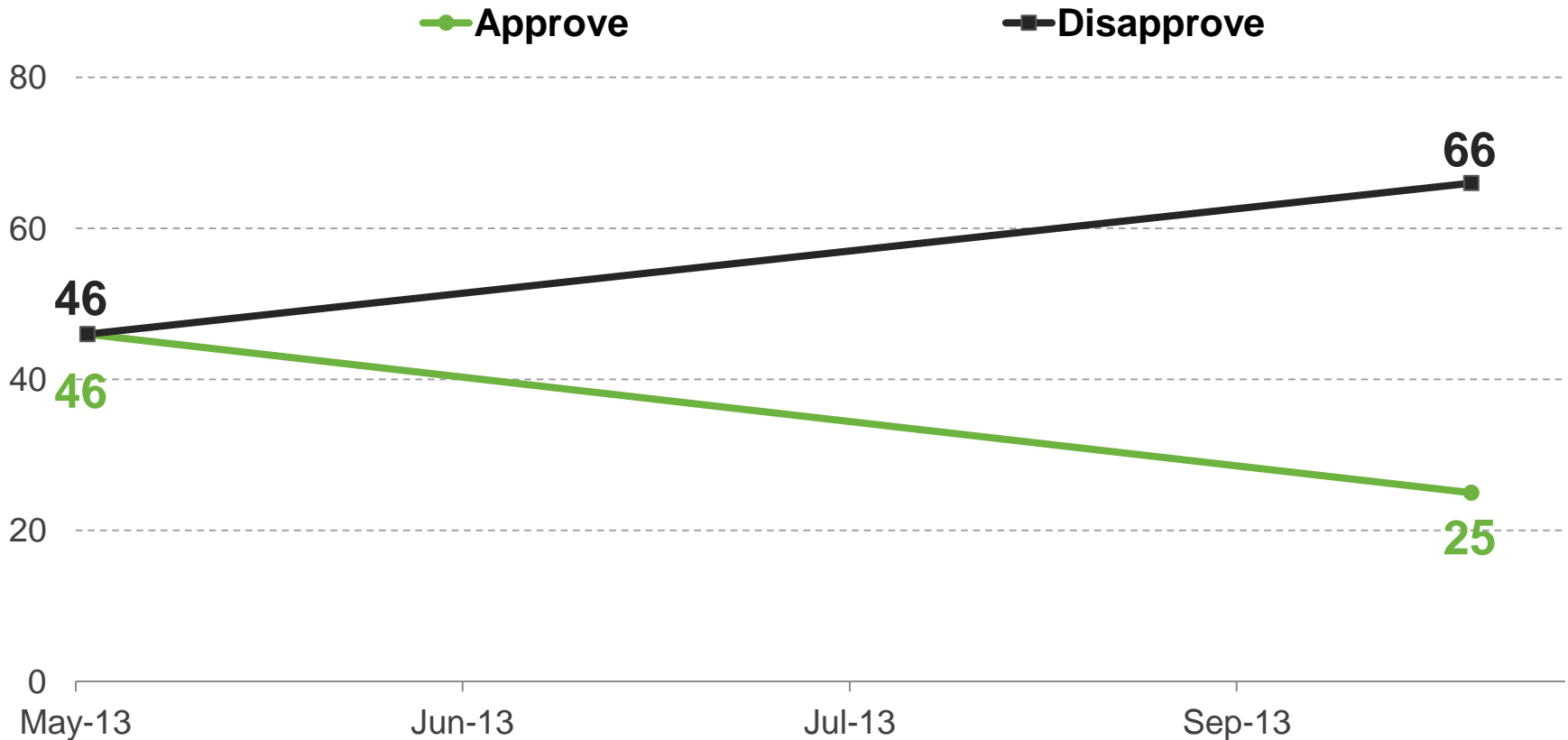
Availability of workplaces

Based on what you know, is the availability of workplaces in your area currently getting better, getting worse, or staying about the same?



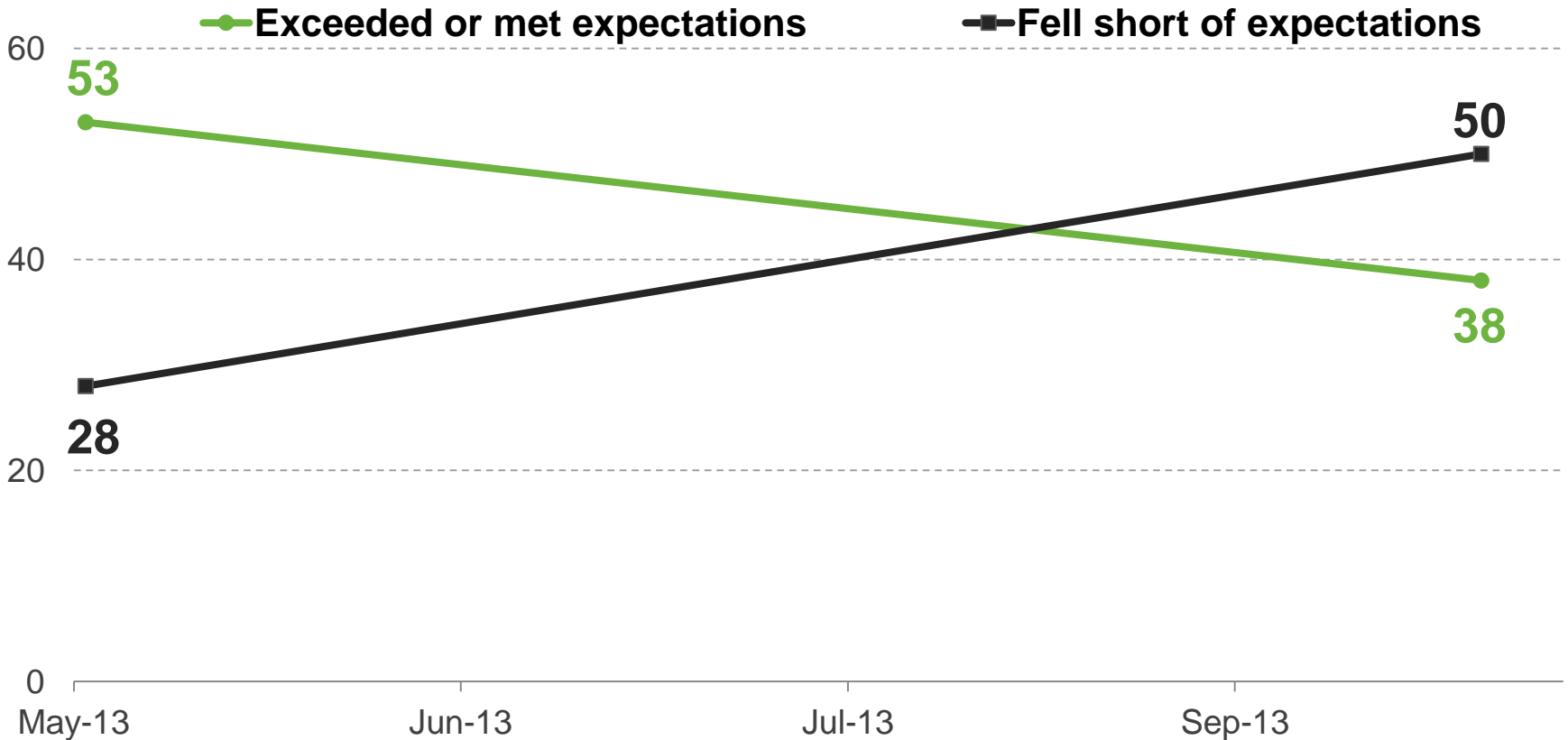
PM Ivanishvili job approval: “getting the economy moving”

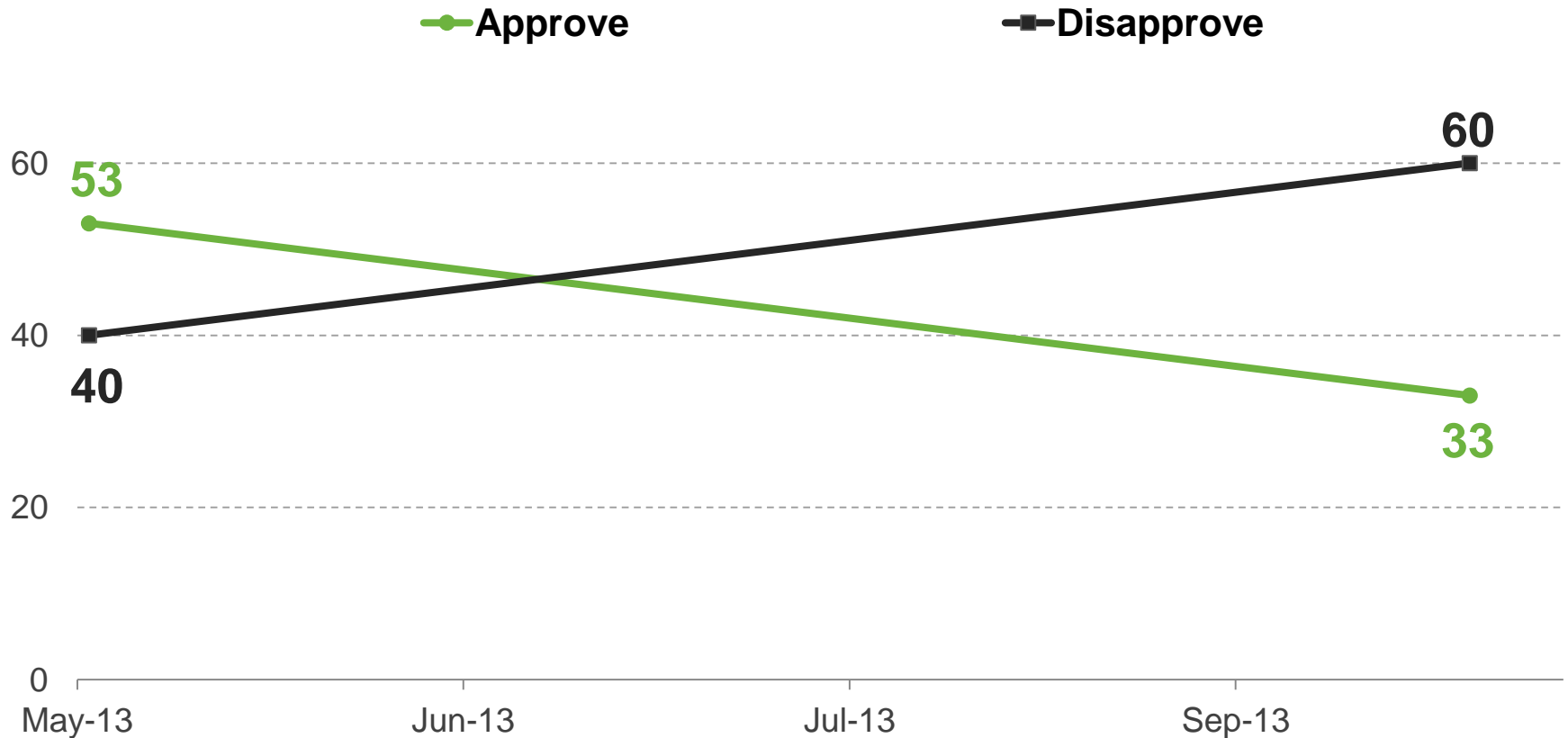
Expectations of government performance
